STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

2. Understand and follow the University's values and ethical behaviours, and the University's policies and procedures relating to their rights and obligations as a student.

4. Be aware of course and unit requirements and their individual academic progress.
5. Submit assessments on time as specified in the unit outlines, Blackboard, or on exam timetables.
6. Behave in an appropriate manner within the learning environment, showing respect for both staff and fellow students at all times.
7. Embrace and respect diversity.
8. Use University facilities and services in an honest and responsible manner.
9. Recognise that cheating, plagiarism, and fabrication or falsifications of data are not acceptable.
10. Adhere to the proper use of copyright material and other intellectual property.
11. Meet financial obligations, including timely payment of fees, charges, and other costs associated with enrolment.
12. Not engage in conduct which may be considered harassment, bullying, vilifying, or abuse.
13. Produce proof of identity and, if appropriate, proof of authorized access when requested to do so by a staff member or security team member.
14. Follow the Dubai International Academic City Code of Conduct.
